

# EUG2026/Confnow! Privacy Policy

This privacy policy will explain how our organization uses the personal data we collect from you when you use our website.

Topics:

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## What data do we collect?

EUG2026 and Confnow! collect the following data:

- Personal identification information (Name, email address, possibly residence address)
- Institution for working or researching
- Information about intolerances or allergies, if any
- Details about your event participation

## How do we collect your data?

Through Confnow! systems you provide EUG2026 databases with most of the data we collect. We collect data and process data when you:

- Register online as a simple event registered user
- Submit further personal data (fiscal code, personal address) for organization purposes
- Upload whatever document concerning personal information

- Voluntarily complete a customer survey or provide feedback via email

### **How will we use your data?**

EUG2026/Confnow! collect your data so that we can:

- Email you with any needed feedback concerning the submission process as well as the acceptance process, if requested by the event policies
- Email you with confirmation about your registration to the event as participant
- Inform the event staff with all useful information concerning organization of related events (visits, lunches, coffee breaks)
- Compile an invoice document for payments concerning event participation

If you agree and if requested by the event policies, EUG2026 will share your data with external companies so that they may offer you their services

- Google Analytics
- Confnow!

When EUG2026 processes your order, it may send your data to, and also use the resulting information from, credit reference agencies to prevent fraudulent operations.

### **How do we store your data?**

EUG2026 securely stores your data through Confnow! support at Unisa hosting servers and specifically in a single database.

Confnow! will keep your data for as long as EUG2026 event organizing committee will ask to do so. At any rate this will be for no more than 15 years. Once this time period has expired, we will delete your data by erasing the database.

### **Marketing**

Confnow! would like to send you information about products and services that we think you might like.

If you have agreed to receive marketing, you may always opt out at a later date.

You have the right at any time to stop Confnow! from contacting you for marketing purposes.

### **What are your data protection rights?**

EUG2026 would like to make sure you are fully aware of all of your data protection rights. Every user is entitled to the following:

The right to access – You have the right to request EUG2026 for copies of your personal data.

The right to rectification – You have the right to request that EUG2026 correct any information you believe is inaccurate.

The right to erasure – You have the right to request that EUG2026/Confnow! erase your personal data, under certain conditions.

The right to restrict processing – You have the right to request that EUG2026 restrict the processing of your personal data, under the condition that the hosted event committee agrees with it.

The right to object to processing – You have the right to object to EUG2026's processing of your personal data, under the condition that the hosted event committee agrees with it.

The right to data portability – You have the right to request that EUG2026 transfer the data that we have collected to another organization, or directly to you, under the condition that the hosted event committee agrees with it.
